# **Chairman's Report**

There may have been a recession, a parliamentary expenses scandal, an Ashes defeat, and Andy Murray didn't win a major, but for Hadleigh Tennis Club it's been a good year.

The Club has chalked up several notable achievements:

- Membership is up and especially pleasing is the number of youngsters we now have playing regularly.
- Our relationship with Hadleigh Town Council and the Layham Road Management Committee continues to be good and we were able to persuade them to reinstate our Ad-Hoc Play agreement.
- We were also able to negotiate an offer of 50:50 partnership with LRMC to replace the lights in the coming year....
- Young players are the life-blood of any club so we were at pains during 2009 to re-establish some Junior Coaching. Under the management of Lee Tweed from Ipswich Tennis Club, Johnny Carr held youngster's sessions through the season until the end of November.
- Our teams have also been successful in the local leagues (see below).

Looking forward we have a number of opportunities to work on in the coming year:

- Finalise the deal with LRMC and implement the new lights in time for next autumn
- Build up junior tennis in Hadleigh. Lee has been successful in obtaining a Babergh DC grant award to improve junior coaching during 2010.
- Further recruitment is important for the sustainability of the club and could bring additional benefits of more tennis and continuing low prices. Please encourage your friends to join and bring their families down to play....and of course we would love to see previous members rejoining too.
- Sponsorship is an area that we have not pushed hard in the past. We have started discussions with a potential sponsor and hope that in the coming year we can come to an arrangement with them.

...and we have been lucky in ways that perhaps we sometimes fail to appreciate:

- We had an elongated season in terms of very well attended Club Sessions in mild weather until the end of November....and we had a well earned rest in December, January and February!
- We shared some successful social events President's Day, a BBQ and Christmas Dinner....where we were pleased to see again some of our social members who no longer grace the courts but whose spirit burns bright.
- We had the opportunity to buy Wimbledon tickets.
- For Club Sessions we paid ~30p/hr (if you attended all the Sessions) not to mention free Ad Hoc play at other times.
- o In summary we enjoyed a sociable, healthy pastime that didn't break the bank....

So, all in all, a good year for Hadleigh Tennis Club and plenty to look forward to in the coming season.

The mixed team played 8 matches in Division 6 of the Ipswich and District Summer League. Opponents were David Lloyd 2, Felixstowe 3, Bramford, Copdock and Washbrook. The team won 6 lost 2 and achieved 12 points, the same as David Lloyd 2. However, on count back Hadleigh won73.6% of sets played against David Lloyd's 65.3%. Therefore Hadleigh are division 6 Champions again and will be playing in Division 5 next season!
